ARRIVAL TIMES

10.30am – 11.00am All dance performers arrive (Jazz, Hip Hop and recreational dance)

12.30pm – 1.00pm Cheerleaders arrive

All performers from year 11 and below must be signed in by a parent/guardian when being dropped off at TIC and signed out when collected at the end of the day. We can accept performers from year 12 and above to sign themselves in and out of the venue. You will receive a text next week providing the name of the chaperone you will need to sign in with when you arrive. This will help on arrival as you only have a 15 minute drop off time slot (free of charge) when bringing your child to the TIC. Please note, when parking your car later for the performance, there will be a £4.50 parking fee.

COSTUMES AND UNIFORMS

Performers must arrive in suitable training kit for rehearsals and bring along all costumes and uniforms when you arrive. Please remember to label all costumes and bring in a uniform organiser, small suitcase or plastic box with all costumes on hangers as clothes rails will be provided. Please see below for a reminder of your costumes/uniform requirements for the day.

All Star Cheerleaders – Full competition uniform, Bow and cheer trainers

Twinkles and Genesis – Black SA T-shirts, Black shorts, White cheer trainers

Jazz teams – Lyrical costume and Jazz costume, tan jazz shoes and tights

Hip Hop Costumes for Avalanche, Thunder and Cyclones

Icicles, Blizzard, Aurora and Tornadoes – Lyrical and Jazz costume, tan jazz shoes and tight.

HAIR AND MAKE-UP

Make-up is not compulsory but if preferred please wear silver/grey smoky eye and red lipstick. You must supply your own make-up as we advise not to share. Please see hairstyles below and arrive with hair already done.

French plait from top of head to nape of neck continue with a straight pony tail

French plait from top of head to end of pony tail

REFRESHMENTS

Please bring along food and refreshments for the day. We have also arranged for some hot food and refreshments to be sold at the venue especially for our performers. Therefore, if they would like alternative lunch snacks, please also send a small amount of cash.

DOORS OPEN AND SHOW START

The doors will open to the public at 4.15pm and a bar has been arranged for our audience. The show will start at 5.00pm finishing around 7.30pm. There will be no admittance to the auditorium without a ticket, so please make sure you have yours with you. **Tickets are not available on the door.**

COLLECTING PERFORMERS AT THE END OF THE SHOW

You will be asked to clear the auditorium immediately after the show in order to empty the room of our equipment. As we have a large number of performers this year, we ask that in order to get them back to parents safely, you please follow these rules:-

- Everyone please move downstairs leaving one parent only to collect their child
- DO NOT enter the changing room, please wait for the chaperone to bring the children out to you
- Sign them out with the chaperone before you leave

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING

Due to child protection laws, videoing or photography will not be allowed. We have however booked Apex Visuals to record the event. DVD's must be pre-booked by Saturday 24th November.

MEDICATION

If your child requires any medication at the event, please inform the chaperone when signing them in who will ask you to complete a medical consent form.
